

#### From Mandan

South on Hwy 6, 19 miles to County Road 135, turn East at YellowTop Bull Sale Sign. Go 3 miles East, 1 mile South, 1 mile East, 1 mile South, 1 mile East, 1 mile South, 1 mile East, 1 mile South, turn right on 63 rd St. head west and we are the first place.

#### From Solen

Head North on Rice Street and go North about 8 miles to 63 rd Street. Turn Left, head west and we are the first place.

#### From Flasher

East on Hwy 21 to Hwy 6 North. Right at the curve, take County Road 134 East at Mile Marker 43. Stay on main road around 7 miles to County Road 81 (you will come to a T in the road). Turn Left and go North 5 miles to 63 rd Street. Turn Left, head west and we are the first place.

## Bull Development at Yellow Top Angus

The 2017 bulls were calved on grass in May and June. Then, we rotated the pairs on cool season pastures until we branded the end of June. The pairs were hauled out to native grass pastures for the summer.

We weaned these calves November 1st and the bulls were started on grass hay and 4 lbs. of head start weaning pellets. We worked them up to 8 lbs of a high-fiber bull developer pellet with flax and oil for energy, chelated minerals and rumensin. They were offered free choice hay all winter. In early summer they were turned out onto grass after we ultrasounded and took yearling weights. We offered grass hay in addition to grass and started feeding pellets again this fall.

We test every bull for disposition. We do not have a single bull in this offering that has a bad disposition. We have adopted the low stress cattle handling methods from Bud Williams, Dr. Tom Noffsinger and Dr. Ron Gill. The bulls are use to all of us working them by foot, horseback, with dogs and motorized vehicles. The bulls have all had practice loading trailers, going through different chutes and working facilities. In doing this, I feel we are doing our best to prepare these bulls for you so they are easier to handle and be around. By selling long aged bulls, we choose to develop these bulls slowly and raise them longer to ensure greater overall success of your next herd bull. A majority of the bulls we have sold in the past have been used for many years and several have held up 10+ years.



## Reference Sires



#### **ROUGH RIDER**

I first saw Roughrider as a calf and he impressed me. I saw him again around weaning time and he was one of the most unique Angus bulls I had ever seen. He was so quiet, traveled well, had good depth of body and he had loads of natural thickness. We went on to partner on this bull and bought semen interest and got the possession on him.

He stamps his calves with great Angus character. His calves have a fancy look and are thick and wide topped. They have looked good at every ranch that has used him. He has been a very good breeder and has covered 45 cows on his own. He holds his condition amazingly well and is a very easy keeper. At our place he was above average on weaning, yearling and carcass traits. The females have exceeded my expectation. The heifer calves have a great look. The yearling heifers look like broody robust range cows with above average thickness, volume and bone. The 1st calf heifers have remained moderate in size, with good, easy going dispositions, and nice udders.

Roughrider has sired calves that on paper fit our calving ease numbers. I only recommend him on larger framed heifers that will be checked. You may need to assist some with how he sires his calves, since they have a bit more bone and over all thickness. Only the bulls with known lighter Birth Weight lines are listed as suitable for use on heifers. He himself has been calving ease for our cows. We have only pulled 1 calf in 3 calving seasons out of cows, but that one was big. Only use his lighter birth weight sons if you are willing to check, watch and assist some of the heifers.

Overall we are very excited about the Roughriders. We flushed to him and we are carrying on with some of his sons. We used lots 1-5 back in our program this year.

## Reference Sives



#### **MAY DAY JAY**

May Day Jay stood out from all the others since birth. His mother was my favorite Primrose bred female. She was moderate in size, very angular and had a near perfect profile being feminine fronted and then widened out with a strong hip and good natural thickness. At branding time he was a stud and had a herd bull look to him with more muscle then any bull we had raised up the that point. He excelled from weaning to yearling and we used him naturally as a yearling. He has strong libido. He has bred every group of cows and heifers well with very few opens. His sons are very complete, well balanced with good muscling and confident dispositions.

He was our high selling bull a few years ago, and was purchased by the Gullickson's at Diamond J Ranch of Cannonball. We retained ½ interest and ½ possession on him and used him after he worked for Gullicksons. They have been happy with their calves out of him. Some of their top replacement heifers they kept were out of him. Some of the nicest, thickest and heaviest steers were also out of him.

We calved his first daughters this spring, and they are very feminine with a refined look to them. They are great mothers with neat, tidy udders and with small teat size. We have not pulled a single May Day Jay calf, or a calf out of his sire. Both have been used on cows and heifers. Number wise they are not all calving ease bulls but the way they are made and their track record proves to me that they are. The sons we have listed as suitable for heifers will be truly calving ease sires.

#### **PACKER**

Packer is a bull we bought as an out cross calving ease sire. We used him on heifers for 2 years and he was the lightest calving ease sire we have ever used. His calves are jet black, have good vigor and good dispositions. We just have two bulls in the sale, but both are nice, sleep all night and not much need for checking kind of bulls to use on any type of heifers.




